VISUAL IDENTITY PROGRAM

Background

Principals are responsible for the quality of school communications with their staff, students, community, and the Division.

The effective use of a school and Division logo is an integral part of the school's visual identity program.

Procedures

- 1. The Good Spirit School Division logo is to be used on all school printed materials and printed community (public) information.
- 2. All schools are to utilize the division standardized template for correspondence as provided in AP157 Appendix School Letterhead.
- Schools must have their own distinctive logo to be used on supplies, letterheads, publications, and other printed material.
- 4. Schools are required to have at least one color and one grayscale copy of each of the following formats: .png, .jpg, .pdf and either of .ai or .eps formats.
- 5. If a school creates a new school logo they must receive prior approval of the Director or designate.

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
